## **GUIDE FOR AUTHORS**

Vehicle Electronics accepts articles from companies and indviduals in the industry. We do not pay a fee for these and any articles submitted will be edited by our team for both style and content. To make this process easier, we ask authors to follow these basic guidelines.

- 1. Our articles are normally in the 1000 to 1500 word range though we sometimes go above and below that.
- 2. They should be submitted as plain text or as a Word document; we do not accept PDFs.
- 3. Articles should be written in the third person no I, we or you etc.
- 4. Bylined articles cannot mention by name any products and services from the company in the byline.
- 5. We do accept unbylined case studies that can mention named products, but these should be written from the client's point of view, looking at what problems they had, what ways they had tried to solve those problems and why they were rejected, before going on to talk about the chosen method.
- 6. All articles must include a selection of high resolution images with captions. These should be sent as separate files, ie not embedded in the Word document. The pictures should be sent at the same time as the article; articles that arrive without images will not be considered for publication.
- 7. Remember, our readers are engineers and the article should be directed at such a readership.
- Each issue will be published early in the month.
- Suggestions for features should be sent to the editor at least two months before publication.
